

#### Create and Curate Your Digital Identity

- Online presence vs. privacy concerns
  - •How are we being presented in an online space?
  - •If you don't create a presence, someone will for you.
    - Think about someone else searching for you online.
  - What will you share? Keep private? Images? Color? Design?
  - Keep this consistent throughout all social media accounts.

#### Digitize Your Workflow

Microsoft Office vs. Google Drive

- Ubiquitous access to material
  - Ability to use / access different formats from different devices
- Cloud-based
  - Easier to work collaboratively and individually
  - Work openly

#### Build An Online Learning Hub

- Website (share it!)
  - Teaching space / work space
  - Share information , blog and archive your own material
    - Hyperlink ideas from others and also share on social media
  - Examples: WordPress, Wix
  - Converging Spaces
- Newsletter
