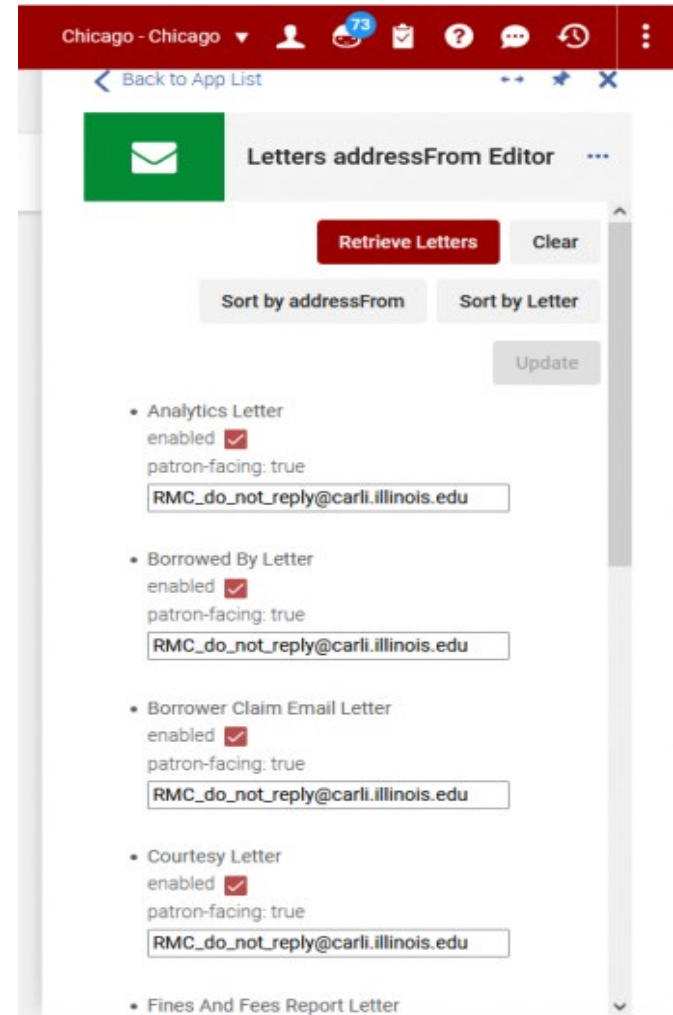

Cloud Apps are applications written by members of the Alma community that run inside Ex Libris products such as Alma, Primo VE, and Leganto. These apps add features beyond the core functionality found in the products themselves.

Cloud App config now includes two new options for controlling usage of cloud apps in the institution. Admins can configure one, both, or neither of these options.

1. The admin can configure cloud apps to be available for activation only by users with the relevant role/s required by that cloud app.
2. The admin can control which users can activate and use cloud apps by giving specific users the new Cloud App Operator role.

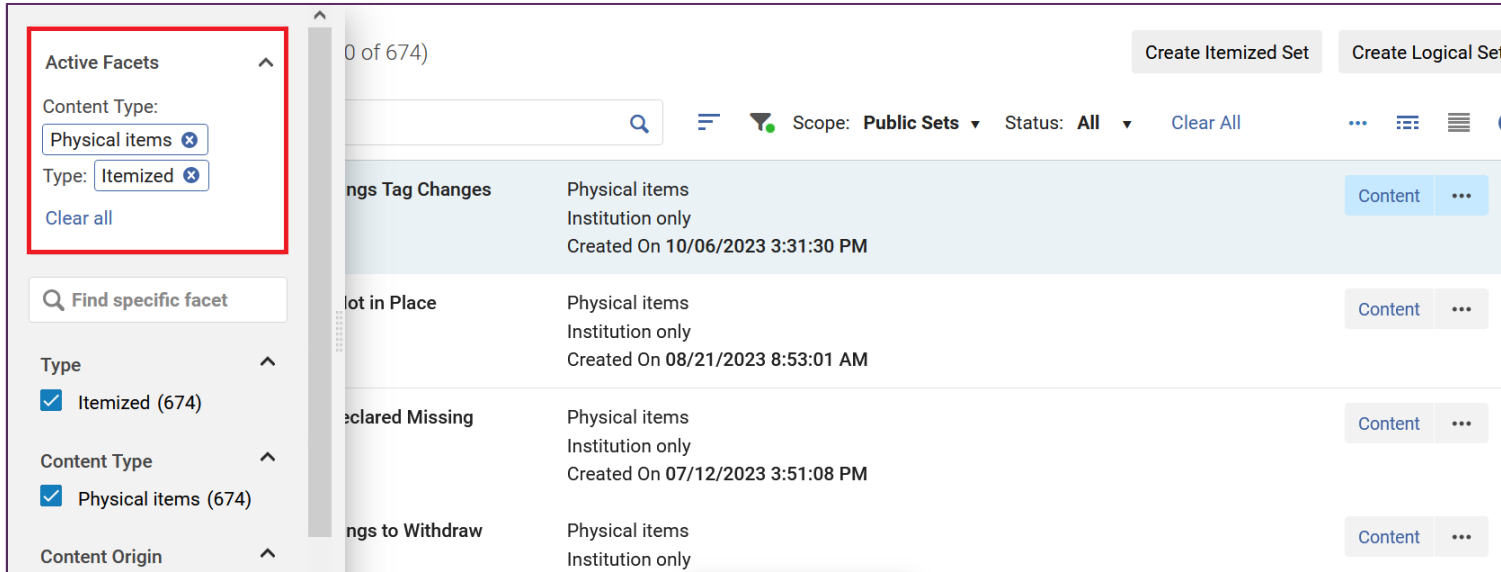

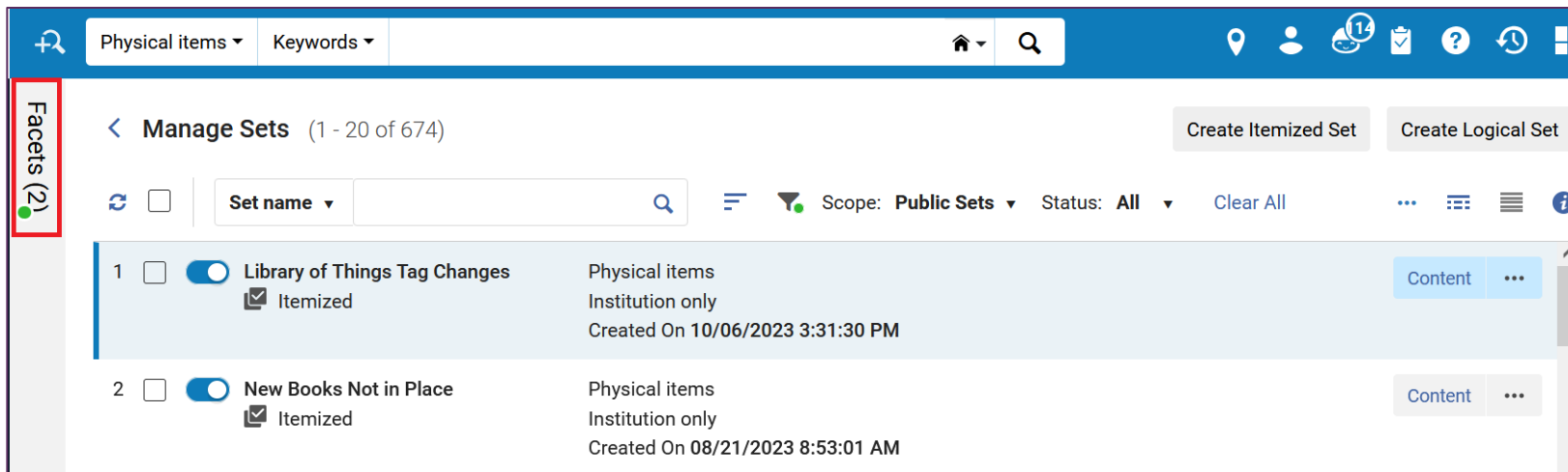


ACTIVE FACETS DISPLAYED IN LEFT-HAND CORNER



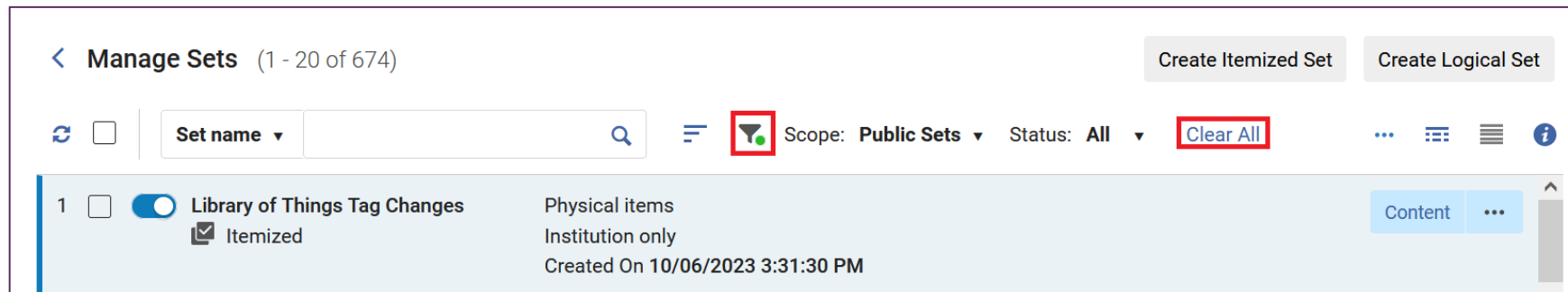

A section was added to the facets for certain searches that displays the actively selected facets. This applies to PO lines, resource sharing requests, sets and relevant searches such as physical holdings.



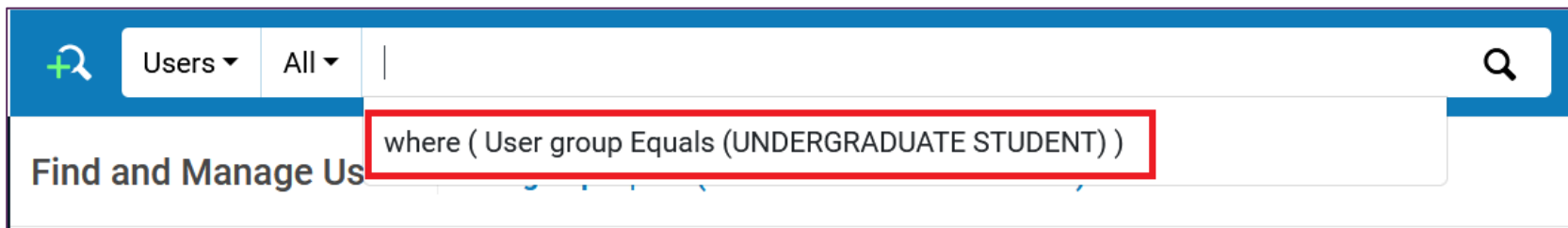
[Image Description: Screen capture of active facets in collapsed pane]

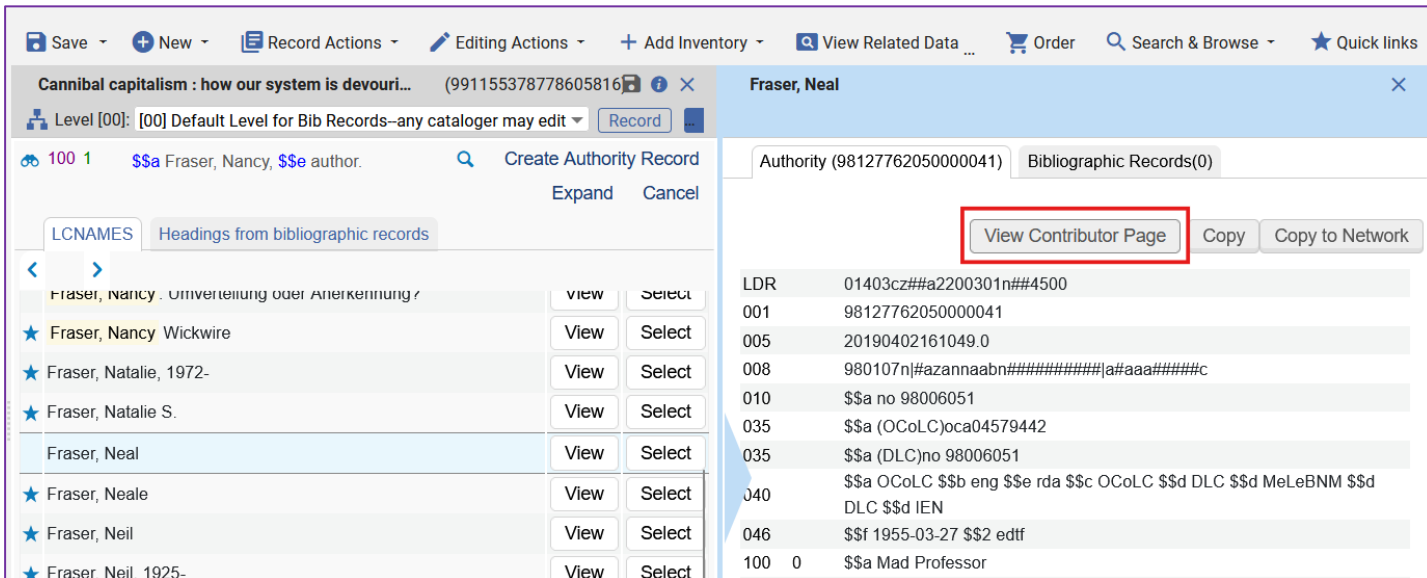

- When creating a new POL Alma can copy the POL price to the replacement cost field.
- This can happen when:
 - A new POL is created
 - A POL list price is edited
 - The quantity ordered is changed
- To activate:
 - Configuration > Acquisitions > General > Other Settings > replacement_cost_copied_from_POL
 - 0 – False (DEFAULT)
 - 1 - Copy the price from the PO line's List price field
 - 2 - Copy the price from the PO line's Net price field and divide by number of items in the Ordered Items section.



Click the gear icon to customize the columns shown in the list of items table; scroll to the bottom of the list and click Done to save changes.



- In Analytics Objects, the feature to select the Alma roles that have access to an analytics object were enhanced.
 - You can now open a dialog box and select the roles with which you want to share the analytics object.
 - The roles are categorized to make it easier to find specific roles.
 - You can select all of the roles in the category or select specific roles within a category.
- The next slide will show a side-by-side comparison between the previous Analytics Objects method of selecting a role in comparison to the new enhanced method.

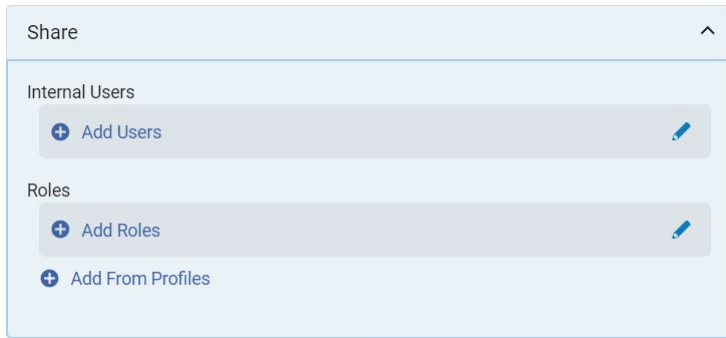




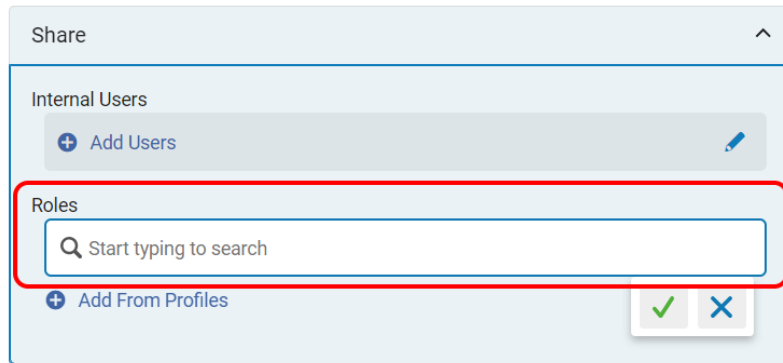

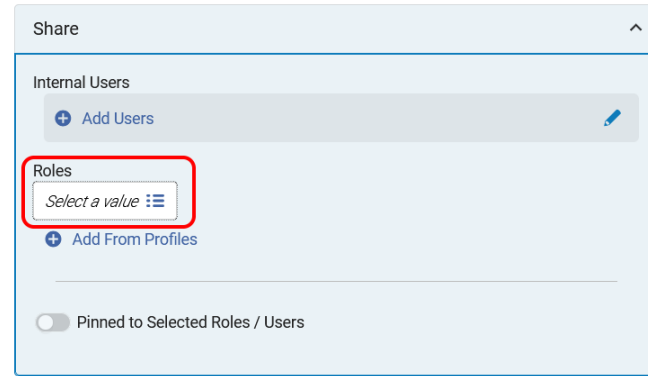

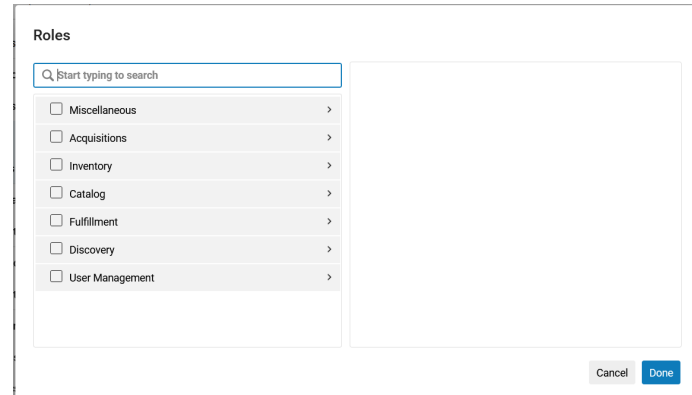


[Image Description: Previous Analytics Object's "Share" pane after clicking into the Roles field. The Roles field is enclosed in a red rectangle.]

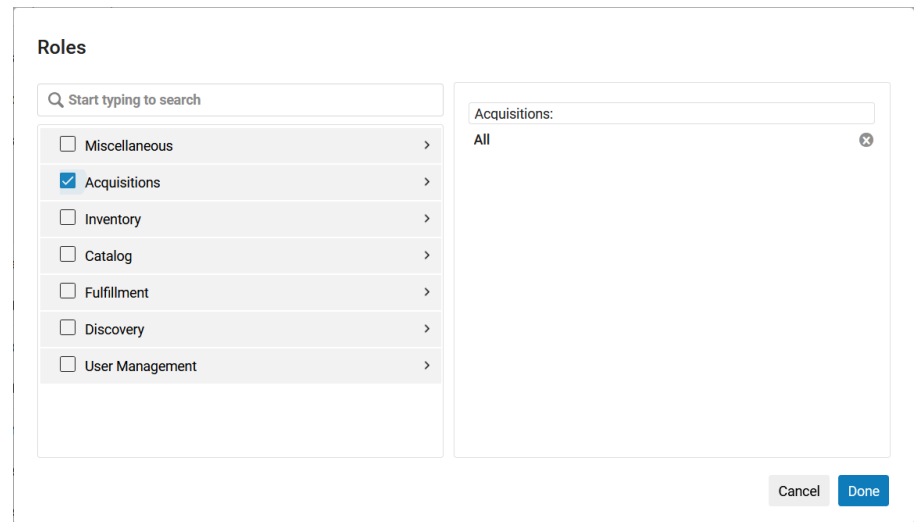
[Image Description: Enhanced Analytics Object's "Share" pane. The new Roles selection is enclosed in red.]



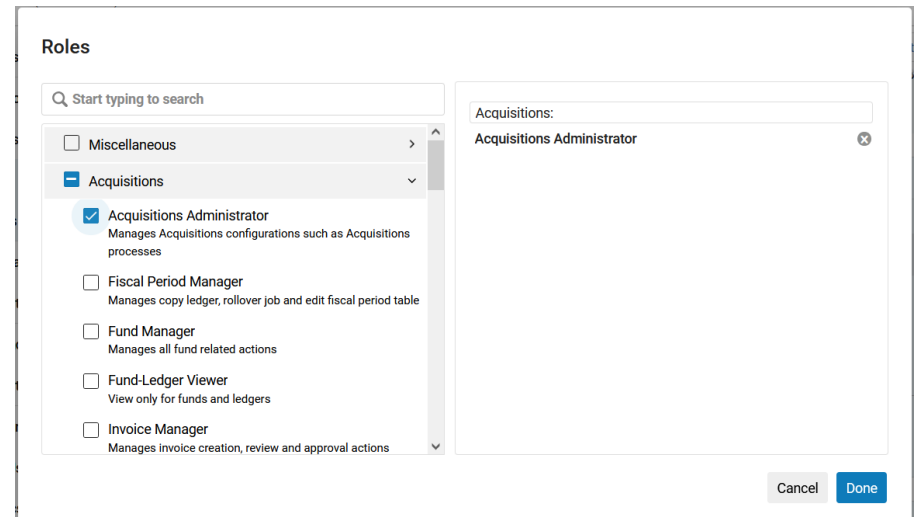
[Image Description: Enhanced Analytics Object's Roles pop-up window allows for enhanced selection of the Alma roles to share this object.]



- One possible option, selecting all of the Alma roles in a particular category, i.e. all of the acquisitions related roles in Alma are selected.
- A second possible option, choosing just a single Alma role, i.e. just “Acquisitions Administrator” is selected.



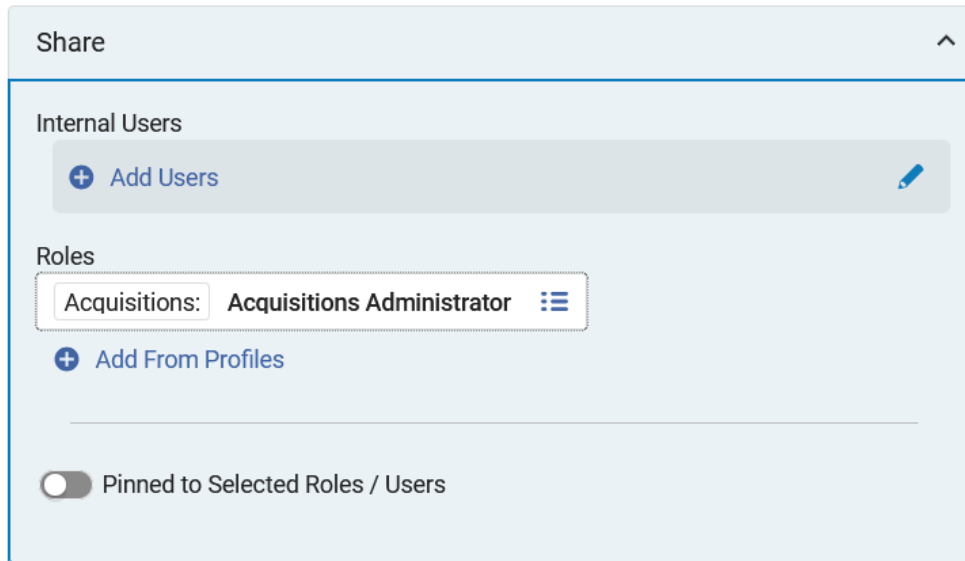

- In this new enhanced role selection feature, the role of “Acquisitions Administrator” has been selected for this analytics object.
 - This Analytics object will be shared with all Alma users at this institution who have the role of Acquisitions Administrator.
 - Note the “Pinned to Selected Roles / Users” toggle can now be toggled. This toggle is only enabled after roles or users are selected.

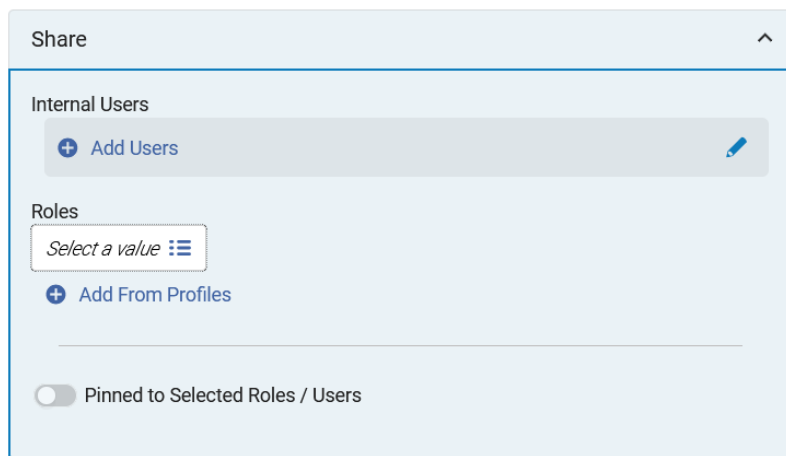


[Image Description: Enhanced Analytics Object's "Share" pane showing the role of "Acquisitions Administrator" is selected.]

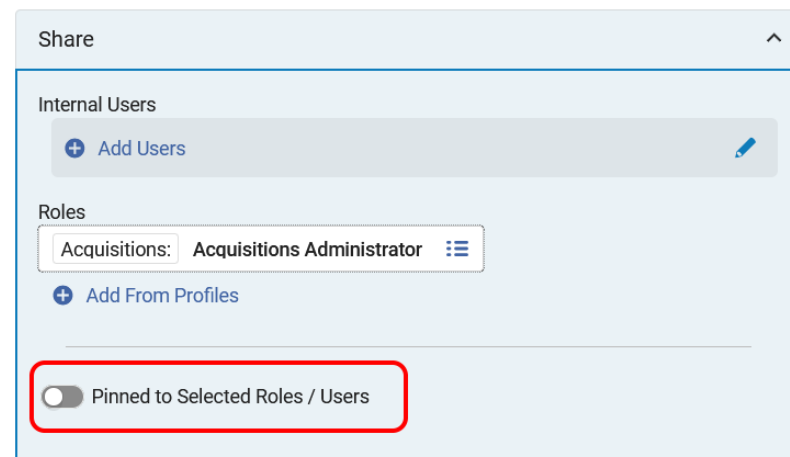




- In addition to being able to more easily select the Alma user roles that you want to share an Analytics object with, it is now also possible to pin that particular Analytics object for those specific roles (or users) with whom you shared the object.
- In the previous example, the Analytics object was shared with all users who have the role of Acquisitions Administrator at this institution.
- Toggling the “Pinned to Selected Roles / Users” button will “pin” this Analytics object for all Alma users who have the Acquisitions Administrator role.

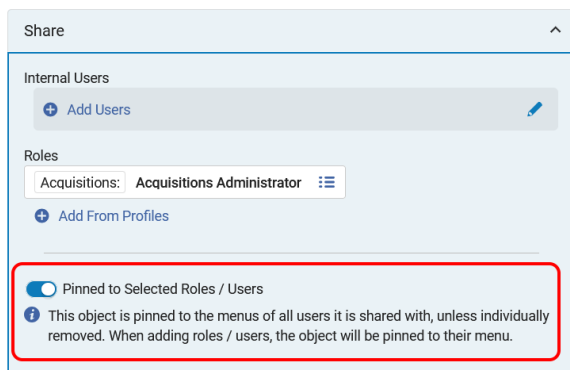

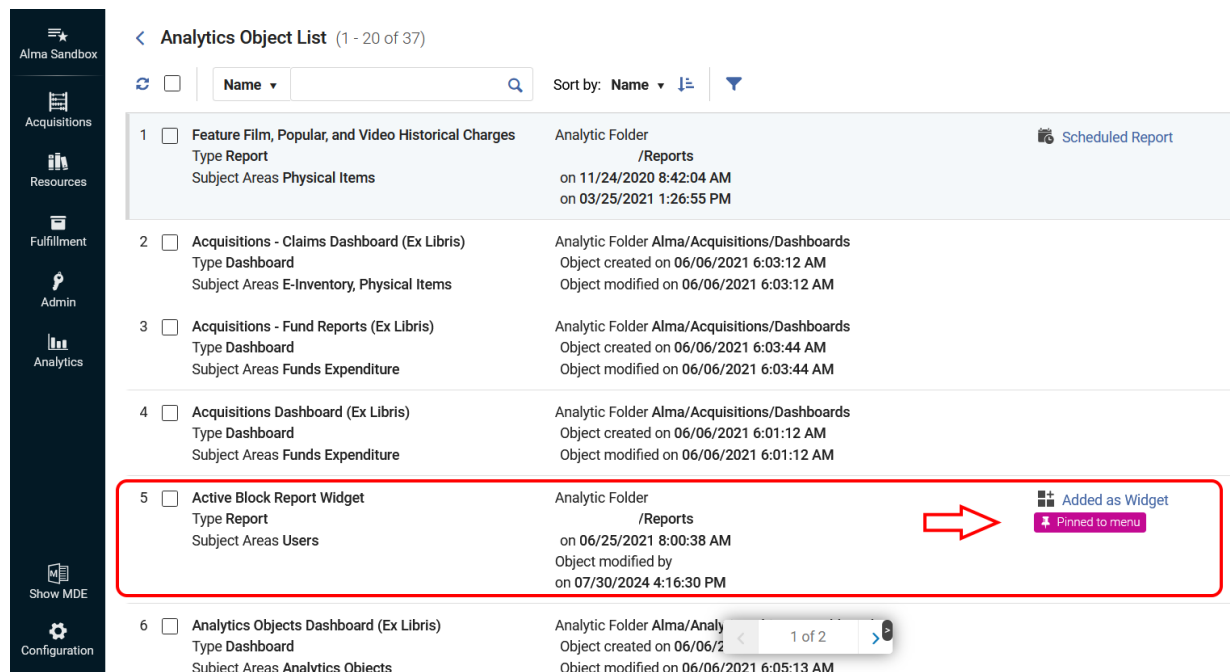

- In this example, toggling “Pinned to Selected Roles/Users”, pins that specific Analytics Object for all users with the Acquisitions Administrator role.
 - The object is pinned to the menu of all users it is shared with, unless individually removed by that user.
 - When roles or users are added, the object will be pinned to their Analytics menu.
 - Users are able to remove pinned items that were shared by an administrator.
 - Below is an image (left) of the toggle enabled and an image (right) of the Alma Analytics Object List that shows the “Active Block Report Widget” pinned for this user by the administrator.



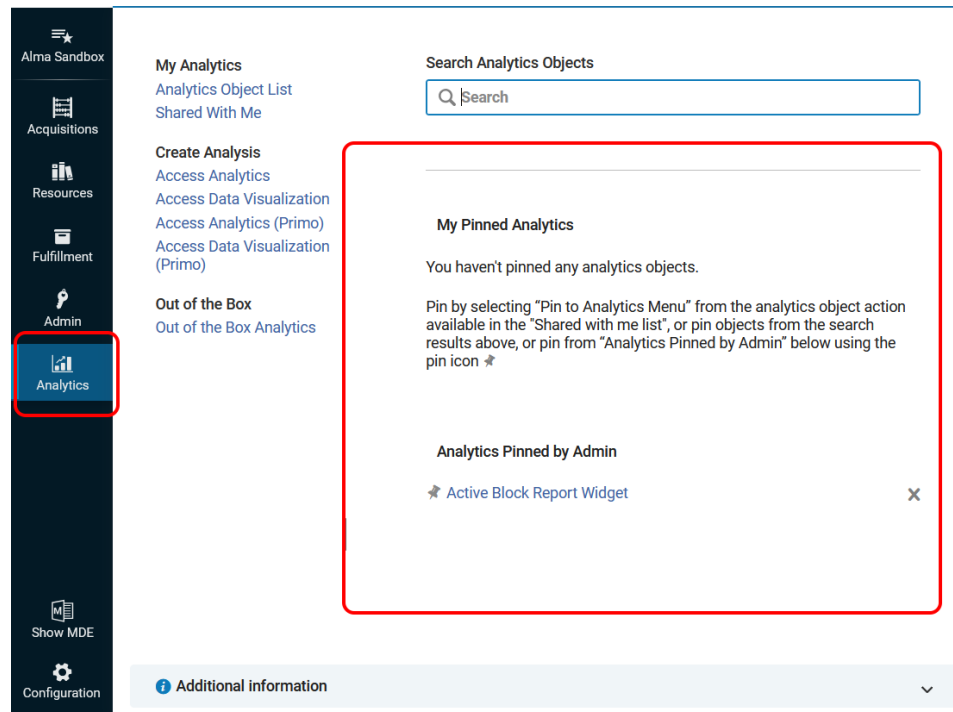

- IZs can now enable **Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA)** for users who sign in to Alma with a local-to-Alma login.
 - Username and password are both stored directly in Alma
 - Not for users authenticating with single sign-on systems
- Relies on the email address in the Alma user record to receive a message (Alma Letter) with a link to log in.
- Three configuration options in: Configuration Menu > User Management > General > Other Settings > mfa_for_alma_hep
 1. none - the default; means it is disabled
 2. [suggest](#) – Alma recommends MFA every time user logs in; allows the user to choose to opt in/out to MFA
 3. [force](#) – all users will be forced to use MFA and log in with a link received in email



1. How many and what kinds of users will be affected?
 - Does not affect single sign-on
 - Will affect any Backup Administrators in your IZ
 - Will affect all CARLI Staff
2. The email address in the user record must be correct in order for the user to receive the login link.
 - PLEASE DO NOT ENABLE this setting in our shared Sandboxes
3. The email is sent by Alma Letter (*Login Using One Time Token Letter*); email configurations must be working with Alma; may wish to customize the Letter and addressFrom email address.
4. If you do decide to investigate this feature in your IZ, start with “suggest” to see how it works and coordinate with some staff for hands-on testing.

Support Bulk Export of All Search Results

- Users can now export all (or almost all) search results
 - Limit of 5,000 records exported from local searches
 - Limit of 10,000 records when using a blended search that includes CDI records
- User must be signed into Primo VE to use
- Export formats of Excel/CSV, RIS, or BIBTEX only
- Not supported on mobile devices
- Functionality enabled by default
 - Disable from Brief Record Display tab - clear the **Enable Export All option** check box.
- Labels may be changed. See Primo VE release notes for all label codes.

When a user is logged in and has performed a search in Primo VE, select at least one search result. The new option of "Export All Results" will appear at the top of the results list. Click on the link to display options.

Lewis, C. S. (Clive Staples), 1898-1963

British writer, lay theologian and scholar (1898–1963)

Clive Staples Lewis (29 November 1898 – 22 November 1963) was a British writer, literary scholar, and Anglican lay theologian. He held academic positions in English literature at both Magdalen College, Oxford (1925–1954), and Magdalene College, Cambridge (1954–1963). He is best known as the author of *The Chronicles of Narnia*, but he is also noted for his other works of fiction, such as *The Screwtape Letters* and *The Space Trilogy*, and for his non-fiction Christian apologetics, including *Mere Christianity*, *Miracles*, and *The Problem of Pain*. Lewis was a close friend of J. R. R. Tolkien, author of *The Lord of the Rings*. Both men served on the English faculty at Oxford University and were active in the informal Oxford literary group known as the Inklings.
